2ND E-36 World Open Feb. 7, 2015 at the Isaacson Winter Classic



The World Open is a composite (two-part) event:

1. Saturday, February 7th, 8 a.m. - 5 p.m, The regular Isaacson E-36 event flown to AMA rules. Three flights plus flyoffs. No rounds.

2. Saturday February 7th, ~5:15-5:30 p.m. Single attempt for single unlimited "champagne flight" timed to the ground, 15-second (or 10s in case of sustained wind over 3 meters per second) motor run. Launch window will be a 10-minute FAI-style round from a flight line. Models must meet all AMA E-36 rules. In case of wind over 6 meters per second the champagne flight will be delayed until Sunday morning.

World Open Rules

1.E-36 World Open champion will be the flyer who bas the highest composite placing in the two days' events. Each event counts equally, for half of your final score. Points allocation is based on percentage of the winning score in each event.

2. Tiebreaker one: champagne flight *placing*.

3. Tiebreaker two: additional flyoff.

Sample calculations

Say the two winning scores are: AMA E-36, 645 seconds; Sunday champagne flight, 185 seconds. Contestant A, John's AMA E-36 score: 583s (90.4% of the first place time), champagne flight score: 157s (84.9%). John's *World Open* score is 87.7%. Contestant B, Steve's AMA E-36 score: 559s (86.7%), champagne flight score: 167s (90.2%). Steve's *World Open* score is 88.4%. *Steve wins the World Open title.*
